

If you own a hand built sports car you are invited to take part in a Six Hour Endurance at Mallory Park circuit on 21st May. Each team representing a sports car manufacturer. Pit stops, car and driver changes, refuelling, 240 laps of the Mallory Park circuit in 6 hours. Each two car team will consist of four drivers, a team manager and a mechanic. The focus of activity will be on keeping the cars running at the required average speed for 324 miles.

No race licence required. The entry fee is £125 per person. Road registered sports cars only.
Free admission to Mallory Park spectator areas & paddock.
